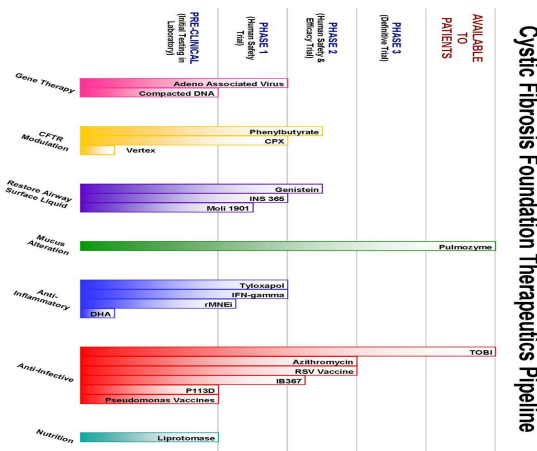




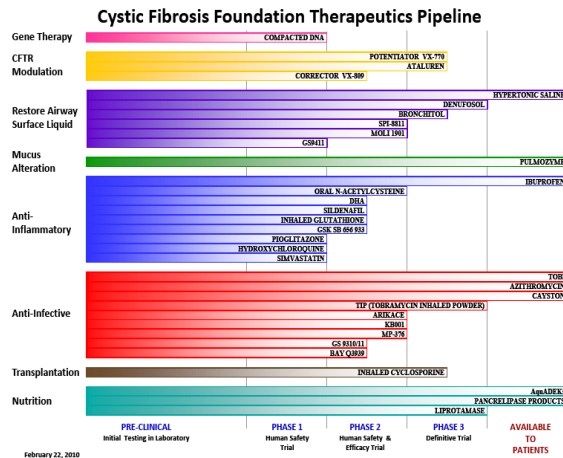

2001



- 20 potential therapies
- 0 potential therapies in Phase 3 (when drugs reach Phase 3 the chances of FDA approval increase to 80%)
- 2 therapies developed specifically to treat CF available to patients

Today



- 33 potential therapies
- 7 potential therapies in Phase 3, several which address the basic genetic defect that causes CF
- 8 therapies developed specifically to treat CF available to patients

For the first time in the history of the disease, CF clinical trial participants are taking oral drugs aimed at treating the basic defect in CF (a faulty protein).

If successful, these drugs could add DECADES of life for people with CF!
